    - a. No major accidents

  - a. COVID-19 Updates:
    - More than half of students back on campus (small learning cohorts)
    - March 1st [target date] - hybrid model (2 days on; 3 days distance) - start with Elementary
  - b. Additional Federal Funding received; need justification for one-time expense reimbursement for consumable items (computer devices, food program, PPE), professional development, and summer school programming
  - c. DUSD Budget is in the green and balanced; 2020 salaries restored to 100%; however, there are cashflow issues (DUSD has not been receiving funding from the State Feb-Jun 2021 (funding deferred to Jul); DUSD borrowing money from within district to meet cashflow needs.

  - i. **Lester and Monte Vista Intersection – Traffic Update:**
    - a. Jan 2020 – **new controller for traffic light installed**
    - b. Sep 2020 – citizens submitted complaints about traffic light
    - c. Feb 2021 - procuring video monitoring system to watch east-bound Monte Vista Avenue to repair the issue; the videos will be evaluated and detect vehicles at the intersection. The input logic will be changed to hold traffic back appropriately to get cars through the intersection safely.

- d. Currently performing quality assurance on the volume counts taken in December but should have any further recommendations completed by end of February/early March 2021.
