THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED:

IN RE: APPROVING EMPIRE MUNICIPAL ADVISORY COUNCIL  
FORMATION ELECTION

WHEREAS, residents of Empire submitted petitions and met with  
Supervisor Paul to study a request to establish a Municipal Advisory Council in  
Empire using the areas within the Empire Sanitary District as its boundaries;  
and

WHEREAS, recommendation was also made that members of the Municipal  
Advisory Council be elected rather than appointed; and

WHEREAS, notice of public hearing was given by publication in the  
Modesto Bee, a newspaper of general circulation published in the County of  
Stanislaus on June 17, 1989, and the Hughson Chronicle on June 20, 1989, and  
this Board finds that legal notice has been given; and

WHEREAS, the Chairman called the public hearing, and all interested  
parties, both for and against the proposal were given the opportunity to testify  
and thereafter the public hearing was closed,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the formation of a Municipal  
Advisory Council in Empire with boundaries corresponding with the boundaries of  
the Empire Sanitary District be, and hereby is, approved; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that an election for five members of the Empire  
Municipal Advisory Council be, and is hereby, approved for November 7, 1989.
