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- a. Self-Help Enterprises, Stephanie Mercado came to present on the Turlock Subbasin Multi-benefit Land Repurposing Program (MLRP). MLRP is a re-purposing project working with the California Department of Conservation to help reduce reliance on groundwater. The program is 100% voluntary and currently taking project applications for projects. Proposed projects must be for a minimum of ten years. The East Turlock Subbasin, which includes Hickman has been approved for 8.89 million for potential projects.
