MINUTES

Thursday, November 6, 2025 @ 6 PM

Hickman School Auditorium

1. Chair Stephens called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. and led the Pledge of Allegiance
2. Roll Call (members present): Ryan Reece, Annalisa Rose, Nicklaus Stephens & Meredith Clark
3. Public Comment: None
4. Member Rose made a motion to approve August 7, 2025 meeting minutes. Member Clark seconded; motion passed.
5. Monthly Reports
 - a. Stanislaus County Sheriff's Office (Deputy Mussotto) – there were four service calls for Hickman in October; no theft or violent crimes. Member Reece passed on concerns from Hickman resident Kathy Main about speeding on Montpelier Road and 4th Street. He asked Deputy Mussotto if he could be a presence on that road in morning and afternoons to deter speeding. CHP Detective Norseen who was present at the meeting said he will request speed trailer from CHP office; however, they can't leave it out overnight. Jennifer Hidalgo is going to check with Public Works about using their speed trailer on 4th Street in front of the school. Chair Stephens also asked Jennifer to let Public Works know that stop signs in our area are old and non-reflective.
 - b. California Highway Patrol (Detective Norseen) – One stolen vehicle since August, and three calls of reckless driving. He also stated that, whether it's posted or not, half-mile stretch near any residence is automatically 45mph zone.
 - c. Stanislaus Consolidated Fire Protection District – Not present.
 - d. Stanislaus County Public Works Department – Not present
 - e. Stanislaus County Board of Supervisors, Vito Chiesa, District 2 (Brittany Harker) – Next Wednesday, November 12th, there is a community meeting with the Valley Improvement Project (VIP) regarding air quality. Community members, local elected leaders, and regional air quality agencies will talk about what's happening in our communities and how we can make our air cleaner and healthier. It is from 10 – 12 p.m. at 529 California Avenue in Modesto. All are welcome.

Also, CalFresh/SNAP sent press release regarding where to go for alternative sources of food in our area during current government shut down and suspension of benefits. She will send to Member Clark to display at post office.

- f. Stanislaus County Chief Executive Office, Jennifer Hidalgo – no report.
 - g. Stanislaus County Mobile Crisis Response Team, Horacio Madueno – they had 136 referrals for October, with 25 hospitalizations (18% of engagements are hospitalizations). Horacio noted that while their number of referrals is going up, they are seeing a reduction in hospitalizations. Also, there are less 911 calls and more calls coming through the community hotline. He reminded us that county residents can call (888) 376-6246 (option 4) for crisis team, or call 911 if there's a safety issue.
6. Information Item(s) – Chair Stephens gave an update on water pipeline under Hickman Road Bridge. The project will start in January and will take three months to complete. There will be one-way traffic across the bridge from 7a.m. – 5 p.m. during that time. The existing wells in Hickman will remain in place as a back-up system.
 7. Action Item(s) – Approval of 2026 Hickman MAC calendar. Member Reece made a motion to approve; Member Rose seconded. Motion passed.
 8. Correspondence – None
 9. Council Comments and Suggestions for Future Agendas – Member Reece brought up lack of agenda items and suggested we cancel future meetings if there are no presentations, action items, etc. scheduled.
