G. Chief Executive Office

Erica Inacio explained that everyone in Keyes should have received a Civic Mic Mailer. This explained that the County received \$109 million and of that, \$50 million has been set aside for infrastructure improvements (water, sewer, street lighting and sidewalks). Stanislaus County would like your feedback on how to use the funds to improve your Community. The community can participate in the survey. The data collected will be used with a criteria to make recommendations to the Board. The Board is expected to hear the results in July.

H. Keyes Community Services District

General Manager Ernie Garza spoke about the Keyes CSD completing the lift station on Foote Rd as well as the upsizing of the sewer line that will be taking place on Keyes Rd. A member of the Community asked if the Truck Center would be bringing business to Keyes after it is finished.
