1. Canyon Tunnel Project: Katie Patterson 209-249-4624. SSJOD (South San Joaquin Irrigation District with OID (Oakdale Irrigation District is constructing a bypass tunnel for its Joint Supply Canal. The existing canal has suffered Land Slide impacting the distribution of Water. Without the Canal Tunnel Supply to Manteca, Lathrop, Tracy and Local farmers are at risk. The Project needs funding approval. On February 4, 2025, there will be a Community Meeting held at the Knights Ferry Community Club for current status and updates.

The Community of Knights Ferry is particularly interested in Heavy Truck Traffic and Construction Equipment hauling through town. We are currently experiencing failure of our Water Distribution system due to Heavy Truck Traffic.
