MINUTES

Tuesday, June 27, 2023, at 7:00 PM

1. Meeting called to order at 7:00 PM and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.
2. Welcome and Roll Call. Members present: Karen Gorne, Brad Johnson, John Martin, Debby Schneider, and January Patel
3. Approval of Minutes for April 25, 2023 and May 23, 2023. Motion by Martin; seconded by Schneider. Motion carried.
4. Announcements and Recognition: Gorne thanked the Salida Library for the Summer Reading Challenge and other activities.
5. Public Comment
 - Water concerns referred to City of Modesto.
 - Vizcaya resident concerned about having only one entrance/exit for the subdivision; issues with motorists speeding and ignoring stop signs; and lack of lights on Pirrone outside Vizcaya.
 - Resident thanked Salida Sheriff's Office for cleaning up Salida Blvd.
6. Monthly Reports
 - a. Stanislaus County Sheriff: Detective Caitlin Pfaff will send stats to Schneider when available to post on Facebook.
 - Robbery at La Familia; juveniles caught.
 - Callers reporting a noise complaint cannot be anonymous.
 - National Night Out meeting to be determined.
 - b. California Highway Patrol: not present
 - c. Salida Fire Department: Ryan Winton, Battalion Chief, gave report.
 - May 1st to 31st: 152 calls total. June 1st to 26th: 105 total. Most calls are EMS.
 - Register on StanAware.com to be notified of fires and other emergencies.
 - Safe and Sane inspections for illegal fireworks starting soon in the County.
 - Report alleys with fire hazard concerns on the Stan Connect app.
 - d. Stanislaus County Supervisor District 3: Terry Withrow provided updates.
 - Budget for 2023-2024 fiscal year passed. Realignment project approved; Care Program will expand Board & Care facilities. Investment in various programs from general fund planned.



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- Will look into cameras for Vizcaya.
 - Development plans for northwest corner of Dale and Kiernan pending agreement with the City of Modesto.
 - Will talk to Twila Tosh regarding the school budget listed on the Income Statement.
- e. Salida Sanitary District Report: Brad Johnson shared updates.
- An upcoming meeting will present service report and vote on 5% rate increase.
 - MID fee went up to \$22,000 last month.
- f. Salida Library Report: Wayne Philbrook shared upcoming events; complete list available on stanislauslibrary.org.
- Sarah Dentan, County Library Director, answered questions and shared information on infrastructure projects and library apps.
- g. Public Works:
- Bill Martins reported Stan Connect calls for service include street lights, trees, weeds, and alleys; will add Washington and Old Salida; radar trailers out on Covert Rd for a week.
 - David Leamon, Director, discussed traffic concerns over Starbucks. C2 “by right” zoning; land use complies with the Salida Community Plan. An all-way stop at Curtis and Broadway planned. Will consider bulb-out.
 - Majority voted on green road sign for Salida MAC to be placed on Broadway and southbound on Sisk.
 - Traffic signals on Pirrone coming; cameras will be up in 2 months.
