January 11, 2023, Meeting Minutes Valley Home School Gym 13231 Pioneer Ave, Valley Home

1. Call Meeting to Order: Meeting called to order at 6:31 PM by Vice Chair Nancy Osmundson.
2. Roll Call: Present were members Osmundson, Hempleman, Mullins. Quorum was established.
3. Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was conducted.
4. The MAC took action to elect officers for 2023 – Chair, Vice-Chair, and Secretary.
 - Member Hempleman nominated Member Osmundson as Chair.
 - Member Mullins nominated Member Hempleman as Secretary.
 - Vice Chair has been scheduled for nomination at the April 12, 2023, meeting as an action item.

Actions to nominate and appoint new officers and to hold the Vice-Chair appointment until the April meeting was unanimously approved.
5. Public Comment:
 - Mr. Eric Kjeldgaard Oakdale Joint School Board Candidate, introduced himself and shared that he was running for the March 7, 2023 Special Election.
 - Dennis McCutcheon said that the streetlight has been removed in Valley Home and has not been replaced. PG&E was called, and no progress has been made. As per PG&E, \$500 needs to be paid for this action for 4630 Lone Tree. As per Ms. Inacio, she will review further in partnership with Supervisor Condit's Office. Mr. McCutcheon provided a project number and other information.
6. Approval of Meeting Minutes for October 12, 2022– A motion was made and seconded for approval of the October 12, 2022, meeting minutes. Minutes were unanimously approved.
7. Community Reports
 - A. Public Safety
 - a. California Highway Patrol: They are busy from the flooding and reported that Valley Home Rd and Free Love Collision. Another collision. Both injuries. Fatal crash on Valley Home and Pleasant Valley Road(s.)
 - b. Sheriff's Department: Brett Abbott, New Community Resource Officer: Issues of flooding in the County Area. Stanislaus River is below flooding, and Valley Home is not in danger as of 1/11/2023 6:49PM. The area of River flood measurement is on Orange Blossom Road.
 - c. Fire Chief: Mr. Ryan Winton. Much effort in the 10 days to help prepare for the floods and there is storage space such as Don Pedro.

- B. Public Works: Ms. Inacio: Flooding concerns are being addressed in the region, in particular in South Modesto and the west side of the County. Public Works is monitoring area floods for resources and support.

The community is encouraged to report all concerns in the area regarding flooding, potholes and sink holes. Stanislaus emergency information is being posted online: Facebook and Instagram: StanEmergency and Stanislaus County.

- C. Supervisor – Mr. Condit: Public Safety agencies level 1 is the highest and county employees are helping. Citizen emergency response team is in full force. San Joaquin River is the highest concern. Locally in Oakdale/Valley Home Areas have much road flooding. All resources and support are being used for prevention. Levees are being checked in the region.

- D. Valley Home Joint School District, Jessica Caudle: Valley Home School Student received ELOP Support during the Winter Break. 21 students received extra tutoring help from this program.
