1. Call to Order and Pledge of Allegiance: 7:02 pm

3. Roll Call: David Jones, Lori Wolf, and Todd Heinrich were present, Lina Ruggirello-Danzig and Lisa Braden were absent.
4. Approval of Minutes for MAC Meetings
 - 4.1. March 8th 2023 meeting minutes were unanimously approved.
5. Public Comments/Community Concerns – none.
6. Monthly Community Reports
 - 6.1. California Highway Patrol – Officer Moore reported not much activity, one collision and one stolen vehicle. Officer Stowes was rejoining the force.
 - 6.2. Stanislaus County Sheriff's Office – Officer Navarro reported major position action on the residence on Morse Rd. They are still directing a lot of resources to the homeless issue.
 - 6.3. Salida Fire Protection District – Ryan Winton with Modesto Fire reported they had a total of seven captains to cover the large conjoined fire department. Very sad to announce the death of Doug McCullough (30 year of service) and he will be sorely missed.
 - 6.4. Woodland Ave Fire Department – no report.
 - 6.5. Stanislaus County Board of Supervisors – Terry Withrow reported on the good fiscal health of the county. They anticipate receiving \$ 28 million dollars as part of the opioid settlement. Also reported that the CARES court will be up and running very soon. He also reported on the HWY 132 project. They have \$ 80 million in available funding but the project is expected to cost \$400 million and they aren't sure when funding will be available.

 - 6.7. Hart Ransom Union School District – Matthew Shipley reported the end of the school year is almost here. Tomorrow night is the school open house. Also a tri-tip dinner fundraiser and a student talent show, followed by eighth grade promotions and Senior graduations for the Charter School
